This letter responds to the Port Authority Trans Hudson (PATH) submission dated July 30, 2021, to the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) seeking approval of its material modifications to the PATH Conductor Certification Program received by FRA on June 28, 2021. (PATH) has complied with FRA's procedures for submission and approval of programs is described in appendix B to 49 CFR part 242. FRA reviewed the railroad's program modification and determined that the railroad's program modification conforms with the requirements of 49 CFR part 242 for the reasons discussed below.

Your submission states that on July 6, the railroad provided a copy of its program modification to Mr. Carlton Williams, local president of SMAET. FRA received no comments on the program or program modification by the labor organization.

The program modifications are consistent with the model of the previously approved Class III railroad programs. FRA understands that the modifications are intended to provide more detail to the conductor certification process and update contact information. Additional modifications to the submission also addressed deficiencies with the standard requirements of 49 CFR part 242, appendix B.
