This letter responds to the Western New York and Pennsylvania Railroad submission dated June 17 2022, to the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) seeking approval of its material modifications to the WNYP Conductor Certification Program received by FRA on June 17 2022. (WNYP) has complied with FRA's procedures for submission and approval of programs is described in appendix B to 49 CFR part 242. FRA reviewed the railroad's program modification and determined that the railroad's program modification conforms with the requirements of 49 CFR part 242 for the reasons discussed below.

Your submission states that on June 17, 2022, the railroad provided a copy of its program modification to Mr. Mike Twombly, National Vice President Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers & Trainmen Department Head, National Short Line Division. FRA received no comments on the program or program modification by the labor organizations.

The program modifications are consistent with the model of the previously approved Class III railroad programs. FRA understands that the modifications are intended to provide more detail to the conductor certification process and update contact information. Additional modifications to the submission also addressed deficiencies with the standard requirements of 49 CFR part 242, appendix B.
