Notice Regarding Monetary Threshold for Reporting Rail Equipment Accidents/Incidents for Calendar Year 2018

FRA's accident/incident reporting regulations require railroads to report to the agency all rail equipment accidents/incidents above the monetary reporting threshold (reporting threshold) for that calendar year (CY). There is no change to the CY 2017 reporting threshold (\$10,700) for CY 2018, because the overall increase in wages and equipment costs was not great enough to

cause the threshold to change when rounded to the nearest \$100. FRA also intends to update its

regulations at 49 CFR 225.19 to reflect that the CY 2018 reporting threshold remains unchanged.
