

# BROAD AGENCY ANNOUNCEMENT 2019 FOR RAILROAD RESEARCH WITH UNIVERSITIES



FRA's Office of Research, Development & Technology is dedicated to conducting research that improves railroad safety, promotes innovation, and supports national rail transportation policy. These efforts further U.S. Department of Transportation strategic goals, FRA's mission, and the rail industry as a whole.

FRA is releasing the Broad Agency Announcement (BAA) Research with Universities to solicit proposals on a variety of research topic areas that will have a direct impact on the safety and efficiency of freight and passenger rail operations in the United States. The submissions will then undergo evaluation and selection by the Office of Research, Development & Technology.

- Track
- Rolling Stock and Equipment
- Train Control
- Human Factors
