**The FRA Administrator's Declaration of
Emergency Event**

September 4, 2008

Pursuant to Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) § 211.45, the Federal Railroad Administration's (FRA) Administrator, Joseph Boardman, has determined that as of September 4, 2008, the impending landfall of hurricanes Hanna and Ike on the coast of the United States constitutes an "emergency event" as related to railroad operations. Therefore, the Administrator has activated the *Emergency Relief Docket* (FRA-2008-0009) as of September 4, 2008, and the emergency relief provisions of 49 CFR Section 211.45 are in effect.
